The world is at a turning Everything in the world is upside down and man has lost his bearings concerning God and his duty to God. The creature has become more meaningful than the Creator. In the face ofsuch abominations, Almighty God, the Unique Incomparable Lord of the Worlds has sent this humble self as the Reviver of all faith, the Gatherer of the lost souls back to the fold of the worship of one God. For

this purpose, God has designed me as His Vicegerent (Khalifatullah) and Messenger and Prophet.

The world is suffering all because of what the hands of man has brought forward as the evil from his deepest desires for the acquiring of the temporal things of this world. The world is in a critical state as well as humans. The latter are spiritually handicapped all because they have left the straight path and indulged in sins of the world.

# The Holy Quran states:

Those who reject Faith will not cease to be in doubt concerning (Revelation) until the Hour (of Judgement) comes suddenly upon them, or there comes to them the Penalty of a Day of Disaster. (22: 56)

And if not that a disaster should strike them for what their hands put forth (of sins) and they would say, "Our Lord, why did You not send us a messenger so we could have followed Your revelations and been among the believers?" (28: 48)

"And verily, We will make them taste of the near torment (i.e. the torment in the life of this world, i.e. disasters, calamities, etc.) prior to the supreme torment (in the Hereafter), in order that they may (repent and) return (i.e. accept Islam)." (32: 22)

Disasters and Calamities may come in various ways and forms. The world is prisoner to all these changing "environmental values", the world having been unbalanced by various sizzling outbreaks which are beyond the comprehension of man. Such incomprehension must make man realise that all these calamities are being witnessed all because of one reason: *the deviation of man from the right path*.

I shall today present before you and the world at large some examples of calamities which have struck the world this year, beginning from 01 January 2011 up till now. These are but briefs of what have really struck the world. I am hereby mentioning those disasters and signs so that these may act as an eye-opener for all seekers of truth. Indeed God has vouchsafed this humble self countless revelations concerning the calamities which have struck and which shall struck the world if humanity as a whole does not turn back to the worship of their unique Creator.

If we cast a look at the exact of catastrophes to have befell the United States of America alone, we shall see that there had been more than: 138 tornadoes, 20 earthquakes (about 16 out of which from Magnitude 6.0 to 8.9), 2 major floods, 2 tsunamis, 1 earth pole shift, over 20,000 people killed, deaths of thousands of birds and fish.

If we glance at the statistics of calamities around the world, we shall see that the world was sizzled in various ways, be it in form of tornadoes, volcanoes, earthquakes, wildfires, tsunamis, floods, mudslides, deaths of animals, famines, drought, heat waves, diseases, strife, killing of men, revolts, riots, coup-d'états, killing and subservience of (Muslim) world leaders, etc.

#### JANUARY-DECEMBER 2011

#### o1 January:

- Severe drought hit East Africa (Somalia, Kenya & Southern Ethiopia). This drought which has stretched all through the year, especially so in mid-July 2011 is reported as being the worst of the last "60 years"! This situation has awakened a food crisis affected more than 13.3 people. Deaths of both humans (especially infants and the weak old people) and animals have occurred. Crops also have tremendously suffered due to the drought. Other nearby countries such as Sudan also has later on been touched by such food crisis.
- Earthquake of magnitude 7.0 hit Northern Argentina (in Santiago del Estero Province)
- Earthquake of magnitude 5.2 hit Southern XinJiang in China. There was also a repeat of earthquake in this region on 11 August and 15 September 2011.
- Car bomb explosion outside a Coptic Christian church in Egypt's northern city of Alexandria makes at least 21 dead, and at least 43 others injured.
- Severe after-effects of the H1N1 Vaccine. People, including children are reported to have developed maladies which needed hospitalisation in U.S.A. The package insert for the Influenza A (H1N1) 2009 Monovalent Vaccine manufactured by Novartis has been leaked on the Internet. According to that package insert, the vaccine (based on an earlier vaccine product known as Fluvirin) is known to cause a whole host of very nasty side effects such as guillain-barre syndrome, vasculitis, anaphylactic shock and even death.
- Airplane crash, Surgut, Russia, killing 3 out of 124 onboard.
- Philippines floods made about 42 deaths (as from 01 January)

# 02 January:

- Earthquake of magnitude 7.1 hit Chile. It actually is one of the aftershocks of the major earthquake of Magnitude 8.8 which hit Chile last year.
- More than 1,000 Dead Birds fall from the sky in Arkansas, USA.
- Dead fishes cover 20-mile section of Arkansas River.
- At least 500 people have been evacuated in the Malaysian town of Kelantan after ongoing floods worsened during the night due to heavy rainfall.
- Death toll from an outbreak of yellow fever in Northern Uganda has climbed to at least 60, local officials have said.
- Puerto Rico Despite an increase in the rate of asthma in children across the United States, the U.S. territory of Puerto Rico has the highest asthma diagnosis rates in the world, a report said. "Asthma has spiked in the island territory this year, most likely because of heavy rains that may have unleashed millions of asthma inducing spores."

#### 03 January:

- In the aftermath of the heavy rains which hit Sri Lanka at the beginning of the year, 120,000 people were consequently (through the subsequent days) forced out of their homes. These rains caused floods, with 23 people dead.
- Major earthquake near Japan triggers Tsunami Warning.
- Hundreds of dead blackbirds found in Louisiana, U.S.A.
- Ten thousands of Wild Birds found dead in Manitoba, Canada. The causes are still unknown. Either through bird flu or vaccines injected in birds.
- Thousands of Birds just fall from the sky in South America.
- Major Flood in Rockhampto, Australia one of the worst floods in Australia, affecting 77,000 people.

## 04 January:

- Dead birds found in Kentucky, U.S.A.
- 100 tons of dead fish wash up on Brazil's shores.

## o5 January:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.3 struck Loyalty Islands, New Caledonia.
- Earthquake of Magnitude 5.4 struck South of Iran, injuring 16 people and damaging homes.
- Hundreds of dead birds found in East Texas, U.S.A.
- Dead birds in Sweden.
- Millions of dead fish in Maryland (U.S.A), Brazil and New Zealand.
- Shift of Earth's magnetic north pole affects Tampa (in Florida, U.S.A) International airport.

# o6 January:

- 40,000 velvet swimming crabs found dead on the Thanet shoreline (beaches) in England. Dead starfish, lobsters, sponges and anemones were also found. The sudden deaths of so many animals (first birds, fish and crabs etc. in thousands causing upheaval in the world as to the why of all these happenings).
- Major floods and mudslides leave at least 35 dead in Brazil.

## o8 January:

• Shooting in Tucson, Arizona (USA) where nineteen or twenty people were shot, out of which 6 were fatal. Many of them were high-profiled figures. A little girl (9 years old) named Christina Green was killed.

## o9 January:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.9 struck Vanuata. Another one on the same day struck with a magnitude of 6.4.
- Airplane crash, Terman, Iran, killing 77 out of 105 onboard.

#### 10 January:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.0 struck Chile.
- Floods in South Africa made about 50 deaths from 01 January to 10 January 2011.

#### 11 January:

• Series of Rio de Janeiro floods and mudslides (Brazil) with death toll at least 1000 people, with damages of about 1.2 billion US Dollars.

## 12 January:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.5 struck Bonin Islands.
- Earthquake 4.5 magnitude in California, U.S.A.
- Huge tsunami-like Waves Destroy Homes in East Indonesia, affecting more than 500 people's homes.

## 13 January:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.1 struck Fiji Islands.
- Earthquake of Magnitude 7.0 struck Loyalty Islands, New Caledonia.

#### 17 January:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 6.0 struck Southern Sumatra, Indonesia.

## 18 January:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 7.2 struck Southern Western Pakistan – at least 2 deaths.

## 24 January:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 6.1 struck Tajikistan.

## 26 January:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 6.1 struck Simeulue, Indonesia.

## 27 January:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 6.2 struck South-eastern Iran.

## 29 January:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 6.2 struck Jan Mayen Island.

# 31 January:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 6.o struck Tonga.

#### o4 February:

- Thousands of marine animals found dead in Mato Grosso Do Sul/Amazon Region.
- Thousands of dead fish have washed up at Sebastian Inlet State Park Florida. Shocking News according to experts (biologists)!

## 10 February:

• Airplane crash, Cork, Ireland, killing 6 out of 10 onboard.

#### 11 February:

• Resignation of Hosni Mubarak – aged 83 (Egypt Leader) after his people revolted against him in the beginning of January 2011. After his resignation, he is reported to have been under house arrest (April 2011), forbidden to leave Egypt because of charges of corruption etc. Since his resignation his health is said to have deteriorated and he even have suffered a heart attack (October 2011) and his malaise increased after hearing the death of Muammar Kaddafi. He reached such a condition that despite being ill; he was jailed while being in this condition (on a hospital stretcher!)

## 12 February:

• Airplane crash, Bintan Island, Indonesia, killing all 5 onboard.

## 14 February:

• Airplane crash, Cerro de Hula, Honduras, killing all 14 onboard.

## 21 February:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 6.3 struck South Island of New Zealand (Christchurch) – 181 deaths.

# o5 March:

• Airplane crash, Garbuzovo, Russia, killing all 6 onboard.

## o7/o8 March:

• Millions of small fish, including anchovies, sardines and mackerel were floating lifeless in Basins 1 and 2 of the north side of King Harbour Marina, at Redondo Beach, California, U.S.A.

#### 10 March:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 5.5 struck China (Myanmar-China Border Region), with at least 26 deaths.

#### 11 March:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 9.0 devastating Japan (Tohoku), with death toll of more than 19,797 people.
- Tsunami in the aftermath of massive earthquake devastated Japan.
- Release of Radiation in aftermath of massive earthquake. The Fukushima nuclear disaster released twice as much of a radioactive substance into the atmosphere as Japanese authorities estimated, reaching 40 percent of the total from Chernobyl.

#### 16 March:

• 40-feet section of California Highway falls into Pacific Ocean.

#### 17 March:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 3.5 Offshore Northern California, U.S.A. From these calamities we see how the U.S.A also is also affected in many ways, calamities over calamities.
- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.5 in Vanuatu (Islands).

#### 21 March:

• Airplane crash, Pointe Noire, Congo, killing all 4 onboard + 19 other people on ground.

#### 23 March:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 7.0 struck north-eastern Burma.
- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.8 hit Myanmar, Thailand 150 deaths.

## 25 March:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.4 struck off the coast of Japan.
- Thousands of dead fish wash up in Florida, U.S.A.

#### 26 March:

• Hundreds of dead fish found in Midland, Texas, U.S.A.

# **March - May 2011:**

• Spring Heat Wave in the United Kingdom (up to 27.8°C in Surrey and driest and warmest since 1949) gives rise to serious thoughts of droughts for the coming year 2012. Only 78 mm of rainfall fell in total over England from March to May, and some Eastern parts received only 20 mm.

## oı April:

- Hundreds of dead fish and frogs in Marquette Lagoon, Chicago, U.S.A.
- Earthquake of Magnitude 5.4 struck South Sandwich Islands Region.
- Airplane crash, Saskatoon, Canada, killing all 4 onboard.

#### o2 April:

• Airplane crash, Roswell, NM, USA, killing 1 out of 3 onboard.

## o3 April:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.4 struck Fiji.
- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.7 hit South of Java, Indonesia.

## o4 April:

• Airplane crash, Kinshasa, Congo, killing 32 out of 33 onboard.

## o7 April:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.5 earthquake hit Veracruz, Mexico.
- Earthquake of Magnitude 7.4 struck shore of Japan at least 4 deaths.

# o8 April:

50 Dead birds fall into Kansas yard (U.S.A)

#### 10 April:

Dead fish found in Cedar Creek, Texas, U.S.A.

#### 11 April:

- Earthquakes of Magnitude 6.5 and 6.2 hit eastern Japan.
- Dead fish float up in 36 lakes in the state of Connecticut, U.S.A.

## 12 April:

 Hundreds of Dead Fish at Minneapolis Lake, Diamond Lake, Grass Lake, Lake Harriet, Lake Hiawatha, Lake of the Isles, Loring Pond and Powderhorn Lake (U.S.A)

## 13 April:

• Thousands of dead fish float along the shoreline of a river near the town of River Rouge, Michigan (U.S.A). Residents said that the stench was "unbearable."

#### 14-16 April:

• Deadly Tornadoes hit North Carolina and Virginia (U.S.A), at least 47 dead. This was the largest number of fatalities in an outbreak in the United States since the 2008 Super Tuesday tornado outbreak.

#### 22April:

• Dead fish at Lake Chaplain, St.Albans (Vermont, New England) U.S.A.

## 24 April:

• The Sai Baba died on Sunday, 24 April 2011 at the age of 84. He is reported to have predicted his death in his 90s, but he died before and died a sick man like any normal human. In my Friday Sermon of o6 May 2011, I related how I saw with my eyes the health degradation of the Sai Baba who thought that he was God on earth and whom his disciples prayed and prostrated before him (instead of the real Unique Creator, our one and only Almighty God). Moreover, I related about my "encounter" with him in Puttaparthy, South India (2005).

## 26 April:

• A large number of dead fish were found floating in the Ganga at Nawabganj area (India).

## 27 April:

• Thousands of dead fish are hauled away in Lakeside, New York, U.S.A.

## 28 April:

• A massive thunderstorm front spawned 137 tornadoes, killed at least 180 people, and mangled sections of Tuscaloosa, Birmingham, and Huntsville, Alabama (U.S.A).

## o1 May:

- Dead fish on the Calangute-Candolim beach, Panaji (Goa, India).
- Killing of Osama bin Laden by US Army in a brutal raid in Pakistan, and his body is reported to have been thrown at sea.

# o<sub>3</sub> May:

- Lots of dead fish wash up in San Tan Heights pond, in San Tan Valley.
- Deadly Tornado hits Albany, New Zealand; at least 1 death.

## o4 May:

• Large number of fish was found dead at the spot where river fresh water meets sea – at least three spots in Valsad district of south Gujarat in the two days.

#### o7 May:

• Airplane crash, Kaimana, Indonesia, killing all 25 onboard.

#### 15-16 May:

- Major Mississippi flooding destroys many homes.
- Earthquakes of Magnitude 6.5 hit Papua New Guinea, triggering Tsunami warning.

## 18 May:

• Airplane crash, Los Menucos, Argentina, killing all 22 onboard.

#### **20 May:**

• By 20 May 2011, Extreme Wildfire in Mexico still going strong, being the "worst in 30 years", burning 530,000 hectares of land.

## 21 May:

• Iceland's Grimsvotn Volcano erupts, followed by small earthquakes.

#### 22 May:

• Deadly Tornadoes struck Minneapolis and Missouri.

#### **24 May:**

- Deadly Tornadoes hits Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, U.S.A.
- The discovery of more than 33,000 thousands of dead, dying and blistered fish on the Ogeechee River from Screven to Bryan County prompted the state Environmental Protection Division to shut down activities in the river and investigate the cause of the fish kill.

# 28 May:

• Typhoon "Chedeng" (Songda) exits Philippines, leaving 3 dead.

# 29 May:

800 tons of dead fish float ashore in Philippine fish farms.

## 31 May:

• A massive fish kill has not only hit Taal Lake in Batangas in Philippines but also the waters of Bolinao and Anda in Pangasinan. At least 10,000 metric tons worth of *bangus* or milkfish have been floating dead in various fish pens for three days.

#### June 2011:

• Drought in eastern part of UK (East Midlands and East Anglia) due to Spring Heat Wave (March – May 2011). This affected farming, wildlife and the water companies, and caused moorland fires.

#### o1 June:

• Deadly tornado hits Springfield, Massachusetts, U.S.A.

#### o4 June:

• Dead fish wash up in Bulacan and Ilocos Sur.

#### o6 June:

• "Puyehue" Volcano erupts in Chile for the first time in 50 years. Incredible lightning struck the sky with this rare volcanic eruption! Winds fanned the ash toward neighbouring Argentina, darkening the sky in the ski resort city of San Carlos de Bariloche, in the centre of the country, and its airport has also been closed, and the government made thousands of residents evacuate the place.

• Earthquakes of Magnitudes 6.o, 5.5 and 4.4 struck Christchurch, New Zealand.

# 15 June:

• Hundreds of dead fish float up in Delco Lake, Creek (USA).

## 20 June:

• Airplane crash, Petrozavodsk, Russia, killing 47 out of 52 onboard.

#### 21 June:

40 Tornadoes rip through Nebraska, Kansas (USA).

## 24 June:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 7.2 Magnitude hits Fox Islands, Aleutian Islands, Alaska (USA).

## o5 July:

• Massive dust storm hits Phoenix (USA).

## o6 July:

• Airplane crash, Bagram, Afghanistan, killing all 9 onboard.

## o7 July:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 7.8 Magnitude struck New Zealand.

## o8 July:

• Airplane crash, Kisangani, Congo, killing 74 out of 118 onboard.

## og July:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 7.3 hits north-eastern Japan.

## 11 July:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.2 struck Philippines.
- Airplane crash, Strezhevoy, Russia, killing 6 out of 37 onboard.

## **13 July:**

• Airplane crash, Recife, Brazil, killing all 16 onboard.

## 15 July:

• "Worst in 60 years" famine and drought affecting Somalia, East Africa.

## 19-20 July:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 6.1 struck Fergana Valley Region, affecting countries like Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, and Kyrgyzstan – 14 dead people, some 86 injured.

# 21 July:

• Worst Heat wave in Northern America which affected the Southern Plains, Midwestern United States, Eastern Canada, and much of the Eastern Seaboard. The temperature went up to 55°C. For America alone, this was the hottest heat wave in 75 years.

#### 26 July:

• Airplane crash, Goulimime, Morocco, killing all 80 onboard.

## **28 July:**

• Airplane crash, Off Jeju, South Korea, killing all 2 onboard.

#### o9 August:

- Hundreds of fish found dead in lake in Kuantan, Malaysia.
- A ton of dead fish found in River Segura, Spain.
- Airplane crash, Omsukchan, Russia, killing all 11 people onboard.

#### 12 August:

• Large number of fish found dead in Central China River.

## 20 August:

• Airplane crash, Resolute Bay, Canada, killing 12 out of 15 onboard.

## 22 August:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 5.3 struck Colorado, USA.

## 23 August:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 5.9 earthquake hit Virginia, jolts New York and Carolinas, USA.

## 26-27 August:

• Hurricane Irene hits eastern part of the USA (like Carolina and New York), made 40 deaths, made loss in billions of US Dollars and forced a shutdown of New York City. The President of the United States Barack Hussein Obama declared that Hurricane Irene was a "major federal disaster" in such states, and he released relief funds for what is likely to be one of the costliest natural disasters in American history (the other most costly and deadly (more than a thousand deaths) Hurricane disaster being Katrina which occurred in 2005).

## 29 August:

• Deadly Typhoon struck Taiwan and China.

# 02 September:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.8 hit Alaska, USA.
- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.7 hit Argentina.
- Chilean Airplane crash, off Juan Fernandez Islands, killing all 21 people onboard.

#### o3 September:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 7.0 hit Vanuatu.

## o5 September:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 6.6 hit Northern Sumatra, Indonesia.

## o7 September:

• Airplane crash in Yaroslavi, Russia killing 44 out of 45.

## og September:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 6.4 hit Vancouver.

## 10 September:

• Floods in Pennsylvania.

## 11 September:

• Texas (USA) Fire destroys 1,554 homes, leaving 17 people missing.

## 18 September:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.9 hit North-eastern India. At least 111 people died.
- Tornado hits Siloam Springs, Arkansas (USA).

## 25 September:

• Airplane crash in Kathmandu, Nepal killing all 19 people onboard.

# 27 September:

• Deadly Typhoon hits Philippines.

## 29 September:

• Airplane crash in Bohorok, Indonesia, killing all 18 people onboard.

## September - October 2011:

• Autumn Heat Wave in the United Kingdom (up to 27°C) still gives rise to serious thoughts of droughts for the coming year 2012.

## o7 October:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 5.0 Earthquake hits Aisen, Chile.
- Earthquake of Magnitude 4.0 Earthquake hits Death Valley (USA).

## 13 October:

 Airplane crash in Madang, Papua New Guinea, causing 28 deaths out of 32 occupants.

#### 14 October:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.7 struck Papua New Guinea.
- Earthquake of Magnitude 5.9 struck Amurskaya Oblast, Russia.

#### 16 October:

Earthquake of Magnitude 5.4 hit Simeulue, Indonesia.

#### 18 October:

• Heavy rains kill at least 84 in Central America.

#### 19 October:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 5.3 Earthquake struck north of Tristan da Cuhna (an island in South Atlantic Ocean).

#### 20 October:

• Death of Muammar Kaddafi (aged 69), months after his people (in Libya) revolted against his leadership and finally he died in the hands of his people, the latter taking sheer revenge on him after years of hardships and killings under his leadership.

#### 23 October:

• Earthquakes of Magnitude 5.1, 5.6, 6.0, 4.9, 7.2 struck Eastern Turkey – at least 604 deaths.

## 27 October:

- Earthquake of Magnitude 6.0 Earthquake hits Fiji Region.
- Massive Flood hits Bangkok, China.

#### 28 October:

• Earthquake of Magnitude 6.9 hit Peru.

# 29 October:

 A rare October snowstorm (worst, breaking a record that had stood since 1925) barrelled up the heavily populated U.S. East Coast (Boston, New York, Washington etc.) on Saturday, threatening up to a foot (30cm) of snow, cutting power to nearly a million households and forcing at least 1,000 flight cancellations.

#### o8 November:

• Tornadoes spawned from severe storms touchdown in Oklahoma (after a 3.8 magnitude earthquake the same week).

#### og November:

- Africa's most active Volcano Erupts.
- Earthquake of Magnitude 5.7 hit Turkey 40 deaths.

#### 15 November:

• A giant metallic ball, 1.1 metre in diameter and weighing some 6 kilograms (13 pounds), fell out of the sky on a remote grassland in Namibia. Surprised authorities needed to contact NASA and the European space agency for this real rare occurrence from the space.

#### 28 November:

• (Illinois, USA) An air ambulance (airplane) crashed into a wooded area after the pilot reported having fuel problems. From among the 5 people aboard, the patient, the patient's wife and one other person onboard was killed.

## 7 December:

• (USA) A touring helicopter on a sightseeing flight of the Las Vegas Strip and Hoover Dam, crashed into a mountainside between Lake Mead and Henderson, killing all 5 people aboard.

#### 10 December:

 A cargo plane crashed into a school building of Felixberto Serrano Elementary school (Paranaque City, Philippines) shortly after taking off. All three occupants of the aircraft and at least eleven residents of the neighbourhood around the school were killed. The pilot reported a mechanical trouble before crash, and was attempting to return to the airport when it crashed.

## 17 December:

• Pounding rain (causing flash floods) from a tropical storm in Philippines swelled rivers and sent walls of water crushing into two southern Philippine cities in the thick of night, killing more than 436 people, with many caught in their beds.

# 19 December:

 North Korean dictator-leader "Kim Jong 2" died of a heart attack at the age of 69.

# 31 December:

• The World Health Organization (WHO) is concerned about the works of some Dutch and American scientists whereby they have found ways to alter the specifications of the bird flu H5N1 so that this virus can pass on among mammals. The WHO fears that this discoveries and alteration can cause the deaths of millions of human (who are mammals also).

#### **MURDERS**:

- *10 January:* Murder (by strangulation) of an international figure, Michaela Hart McAreavey in the Legends Hotel in Grand-Gaube, Mauritius. She was 27 years old and on honeymoon in Mauritius. She was the daughter of Tyrone Gaelic football boss Mickey Harte, one of Ireland's best-known sporting figures and the wife of a footballer (John McAreavey). Her death created a ruckus in the tourism industry in Mauritius and worldwide, attracting the international press in the case of this particular murder.
- Many murders due to family fights and others:
  - o brother killing brother,
  - o cousin killing cousin,
  - o uncle killing nephew (and vice-versa),
  - o father killing son,
  - o son killing mother,
  - o Muslim sister-in-law (involved in sorcery) killing pious and handicapped sister-in-law (husband's sister) etc.
  - o An old man, aged 71, killed a policeman.
- Deaths because of adultery cases, murder of adolescent of age 16, two young men fight and one killing the other to conquer the heart of one lady, murder of prostitute because of drugs.

#### OTHER DEATHS & MISFORTUNES:

- 12 January: Tragic accident (in Mauritius at Saint-Julien) which took the lives of 11 Bangladeshi (immigrant workers) and 1 Mauritian (the driver). All of them were Muslims, and the immigrant workers just came to Mauritius to work in a factory. They were on their way for a medical check before beginning work. They were 15 in all, 11 died on the spot and among the 4 hospitalised, one of them died while being in hospital. The tragic event took place exactly one year after the killer earthquake which took the lives of 230,000 people in Haiti on the 12 January 2010.
- 12 January: On the same day, a woman commits suicide in Petit-Raffray.
- 20 February: 2 young people drowned at Tamarin, and their bodies went missing.
- 22 February: Lightening struck a man in Bain des Dames Garden, a girl is admitted in a critical state in the hospital and a baby is lost.
- 28 April: Three houses caught fire in Rivière Noire and a high school boy by the name of Saifullah Hossenbaccus (from Royal College) drowned.

- 18 July: Death of the son of the Minister of Communications (TIC) Chedumbrum Pillay, named Lornacata ("Shiva"), aged 19, in a violent accident.
- 13 October: Major accident at La Vigie, 16 mille; 3 deaths.
- 19 October: Accident at work involving 19 workers.
- which involved the former Minister Leela-Dookun Luchoomun (of the MSM Party). She was victim of an orbital fracture and had to undergo a surgical intervention.



- 25 December: Pregnant woman takes pills to abort her baby (4-month foetus), but this resulted in her own death.
- *Many other accidents:* Causing instant deaths of pregnant woman, her husband etc.; On the 24 December, car accident in Rose-Hill (involving my car with that of a 2X4). The other party (Ahmadi) showed his arrogance and hatred *In all More than 160 fatal accident cases*.
- Death of ex-leaders (ex-members of the Mauritian Parliament).

#### **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE:**

• More than 1344 cases for one year.

#### **OTHER EVILS:**

• In addition to accidents, murders, there was also crimes, thefts, rapes, drugs problems be it with those in charge of making drugs enter Mauritius and those who consume such life-threatening drugs. Newspaper **every week** is filled with such sad news. Youths have gone haywire – education is so-called free, but these youths have no proper education. Education begins at home, but homes are now broken and the youths are joining such peers which inspire them evil instead of good. The youths in Mauritius have become violent, ill-mannered and empty of spirituality. The young school girls are becoming worst than school boys, becoming all male despite their sex. All evils are permitted for them in the name of liberalisation and actualising their identity as an independent person, unattached with physical, moral and spiritual values. If the prospective mothers of today are like that, then how shall be the future generations whom those future mothers shall bring to life?

#### WATER PROBLEM:

 Mauritius faces a severe shortage of water. Rain during the year was very sparse. Whenever rain falls, it does not suffice to fill up the reservoirs. And whenever rain fell actually in great quantity, but the water is not canalised to those reservoirs and got loss in rivers and the sea.

By the grace of Allah, I went to the main reservoir "Mare aux vacoas" (in November) to pray and Alhamdulillah, since then, rain fell, and now the situation is ameliorating, despite the fact that water is still under control of the authorities and the government even sensitised



the population not to waste water. In some areas there are frequent water cuts, and water is available at fixed time.

#### **EXTREMELY HOT SEASON:**

Mauritius has known this year a very hot season, temperature reaching up to 34°C.

#### **POLITICS & OTHER EVENTS:**

- Visit of the President of India, Mrs. Patel and her delegation. She left Mauritius on 28 April 2011.
- Partial election in Rodrigues during the month of June (coinciding with Pentecost).

# Medpoint Scandal (an apercu):

- 21 July: Minister Mrs. Hanumanjee hospitalised in Apollo Bramwell Clinic in the aftermath of the shock received that the ICAC has summoned her to question her in the Medpoint scandal.
- 22 July: Minister Mrs. Hanumanjee presented before the ICAC, and had to pay a caution of Rs. 25,000.

She had to present herself in front of the Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC) on Wednesday 20 July 2011. She showed herself to be very brave on the media, but then at the time when she had to be presented to the ICAC, she declared that she had a breakdown and she refused to give an exact declaration to ICAC – she got a "pain"/"felt unease and sickness" and was admitted to "Apollo Bramwell" Hospital in Moka (spending one night and one day there).

Mrs. Hanoomanjee is a member of the MSM (Mouvement Socialiste Mauricien) party. Her colleagues paid her a visit, but not a member of the MSM's alliance party – the Labour Party. The President of the Republic was also present at the hospital (Wednedsay night). About 6.45 am on Friday she left the hospital and she forwarded to ICAC to clarify the "Medpoint" crisis (from June to December 2010). She was at the ICAC for about 90 minutes, then she went to the Supreme Court (No.3) where she was questioned by the Magistrate. As she was under arrest, she paid a caution of Rs.25,000 and signed a bill (acknowledgement) of debts of Rs.100,000 to free herself from the bondage of prison. The serious charge which the Prevention of Corruption Act (PoCA) has against her is as follows: "She did whilst being a public official, wilfully, unlawfully and criminally, makes use of her position for a gratification of another person."

Six persons, including her have been inculpated with a very serious charge sheet. These people include the Permanent Secretary, Principal Assistant Secretary and the others. The inflated cost of Rs. 144,7 millions is the actuality for the buying of "Medpoint". Now, Rs. 144,7 millions! Is that a meagre sum of money? She attended court in Port-Louis, then she came back to the hospital (spending 3 hours there), and then went back to the ICAC for further hours.

The ICAC have called the Opposition to take their testimonial and to question them, but it did not called the real culprits and especially the head of this whole macabre situation (Medpoint scandal) to question them. ICAC (Supposedly against fraud and corruption) is not meting out justice and transparency like it should be.

- July: Minister of Finance & Vice Prime-Minister Pravind Jugnauth along with five other ministers (from his party) resigned and went to join the opposition.
- August: "Jeux des Iles" of the Indian Ocean held in Seychelles.
- August: Four new ministers took their oaths of fidelity to the country at the Château de Réduit.
- *Kamaljeet scandal (DSK)*: Member of the government, his voice was recorded, whereby he was giving assurance that his party shall protect all those who shall follow them and his party shall make them have jobs (through backing). This provoked a scandal in Mauritius, whereby many people condemned such acts, and this affair was first aired in private radios, to be precise, Radio-Plus. The government is not doing its works like they should be done, and the media are making public all its faults. Therefore the government is hellbent in banning all private radios because those radios are making its "sins" public. Consequently, it wants to ban "liberty of expression" and "liberty of media".
- *The Duty-Free Paradise Island Scandal:* A close family member of a Minister made more than Rs.100,000,000 on the stock of this duty-free shop.
- A journalist is condemned to 3-month jailing because he wrote an article on the Chief Justice.

- The President of the Republic spoke against the ICAC and police who are in favour of the government. He said that they were not conducting their job correctly despite they have all proofs.
- *October*: The Parliament's holiday ended on 18 October, and the government finds itself in a really critical situation. The Opposition is really strong, and the government has weakened. Its destruction is coming soon.
- The Minister of Agriculture mistreated one of his officers in the office and the "Radio-Plus" private radio reported this affair. In the aftermath of this situation, the Minister paid the officer (bought his silence) to frame the private radio (Radio Plus).
- November December: The Prime Minister admits the incompetency of his ministers. He is inviting the other main political party (from the Opposition) for an alliance. His ministers and PPS and deputies are incompetent people and there are lots of critics on his ministers concerning "protection petit copains", fraud, corruption etc.
- There is a great possibility according to the political situation prevailing that the actual president of the Republic makes a comeback in the political arena and join hands with the Leader of the Opposition to make a remake of their victory of year 2000, when the MMM and MSM joined hands to put the country out of misery, to remove it from the political, social, economic crisis prevailing (with all its corruption and fraud).
- As for the ex-minister of Finance, Pravind Jugnauth and leader of the MSM Party who formed part of the "Alliance de l'Avenir" (political alliance with the Labour Party and others) admits that this alliance has cost him (and his party) a lot and now he is ready to pay the price of his deeds.
- Mauritius is indebted (more than Rs.200 billion), and therefore there is a debt of Rs.33,000 on each Mauritian (and even the unborn ones also!)
- Budget 2011-2012 Xavier Luc Duval was appointed the new Minister of Finance (after the resignation of Pravind Jugnauth). In his Budget, the new Minister taxed the poor and removed taxes from the rich. It was a Budget which had no measure for development, there being no new economic pillars to assure our (the customers') alimentary sovereignty or our energetic and decent security. He did not announce any measure to combat the impoverishment tendency of the population. He decreased the interest rates to facilitate access of the small and medium enterprises to take loans, but with this measure he shall direct people towards the debt trap, especially if we cast a look at the statistics whereby out of every four small businesses, three of them became bankrupt after some time.
- The Mayor of Port-Louis oppressed the hawkers. Others found in villages do not face this problem, only the hawkers.
- The CPE exams are a complete fiasco; few children have passed this year. Year by year the education of children is deteriorating. The Minister of Education is reducing the "pass mark" to make believe that lots of children are passing their exams and that his program is doing well.
