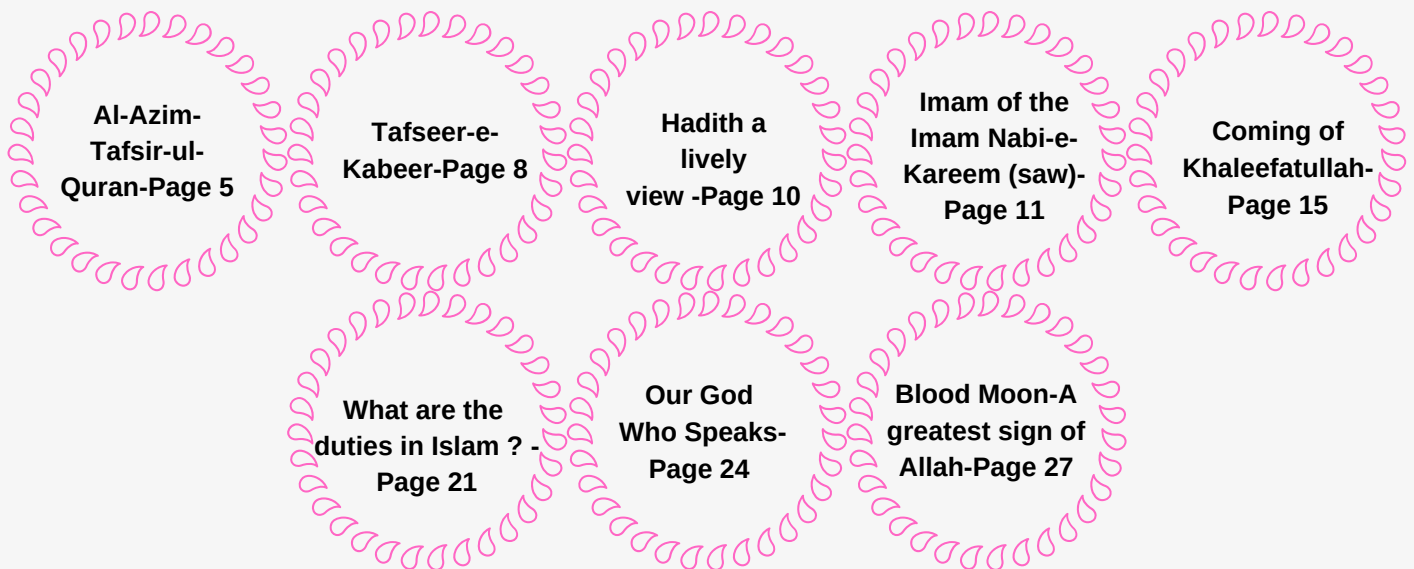

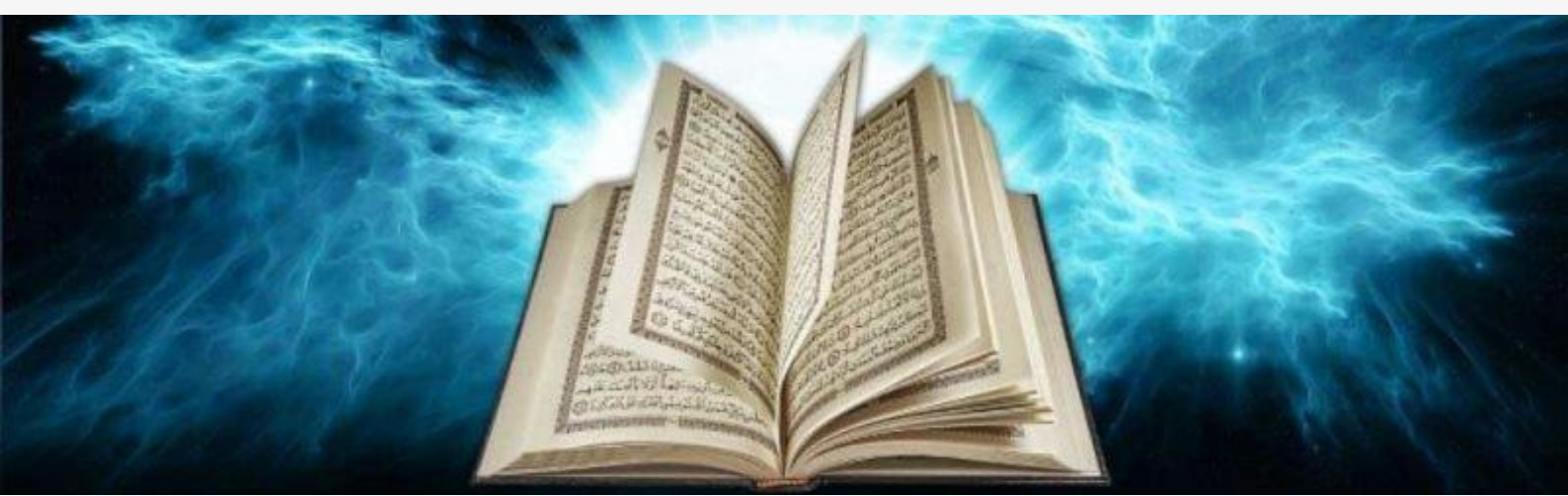

In Holy Quran surah al hijr verse Allah swt says

إِنَّا نَحْنُ نَزَّلْنَا الذِّكْرَ وَإِنَّا لَهُ لَحَافِظُونَ

Verily, We Ourselves have sent down this Exhortation, and most surely We will be its Guardian.

Here is the promise that it is not only the text of the Quran that has been preserved intact by God. He has provided for the preservation of its spirit also. This has been done by raising divinely inspired Reformers among the Muslims from time to time. These Reformers, known in Islamic terminology as Mujaddids, receive revelations from God and interpret and explain the true meaning of the Quranic text. Such Reformers appeared among the followers of other religions also, but that was only for so long as such scriptures served as guides for their followers. After the advent of Islam, however, all other religious systems and their scriptures, which were intended only for specific periods and specific peoples, became abrogated and divinely inspired Reformers ceased to appear among them. Now, therefore, the Quran alone among all revealed Scriptures of the world holds the field as a living Book and hence divinely inspire Reformers now appear only among the followers of Islam. In our own time that is in fifteenth century God has raised Hadhrat Muhyi-ud-din Al-Khaleefathullah Munir Ahmad Azim (atba) the Holy Founder of Jamaat Ul Sahih Al Islam to demonstrate the truth and excellence of the Holy Quran by receiving Tafsir (commentaries) of the Holy Quran through divine revelations and inspirations from Allah and he wrote several volumes of those Quran commentaries called Al-Azim-Tafsir-ul Qur'an. Biographical Note



HAZRAT MUNIR AHMAD AZIM of Mauritius (B. January 07, 1961) is the Holy Founder of Jamaat Ul Sahih Al Islam International.

Belonging to a Muslim family of modest economic fortunes, deep spiritual inclinations and religious services, Munir Ahmad Azim's late parents – Solim Azim Sahib and Momin Azim Sahiba – were devout Muslims. Growing up in an environment of religious piety and spiritual devotion, the young Azim displayed extraordinary inclination for Islamic studies and keen interest in religious debates with both Muslims and non-Muslims alike, marshalling clinching arguments in defence of Islamic values and teachings whenever opportunities presented themselves. It was these qualities of head and heart and fervent spirituality that eventually made him an ambassador of Islam in several communities and Island states, even outside of Mauritius, leading to all round appreciation for his profound commitment and noble services to the task of spreading the message of Islam.

It is an enduring belief in the Islamic world that Allah raises spiritual saints in every age to explain the profound import of His eternal teachings as enshrined in the Holy Qur'an and to be a model exemplar for the living **Muslim community in every century**. While leading a life of spiritual commitment and religious piety, at a time when he was about 40 years of age, Munir Ahmad Azim Sahib began to receive messages from the Unseen, pertaining to a range of spiritual and secular matters that have implications for the future of Islam and the world. While his own people rejected the Divine revelations and expelled him from his community, Allah chose him and taught him hidden spiritual treasures and pearls of wisdom. In the last decade, Allah raised his spiritual station and granted

Divinely inspired Reformers among the Muslims from time to time. These Reformers, known in Islamic terminology as "Mujaddids"

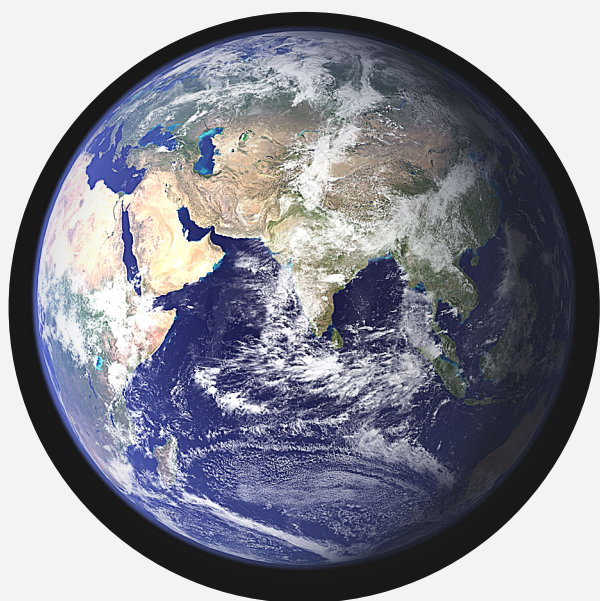

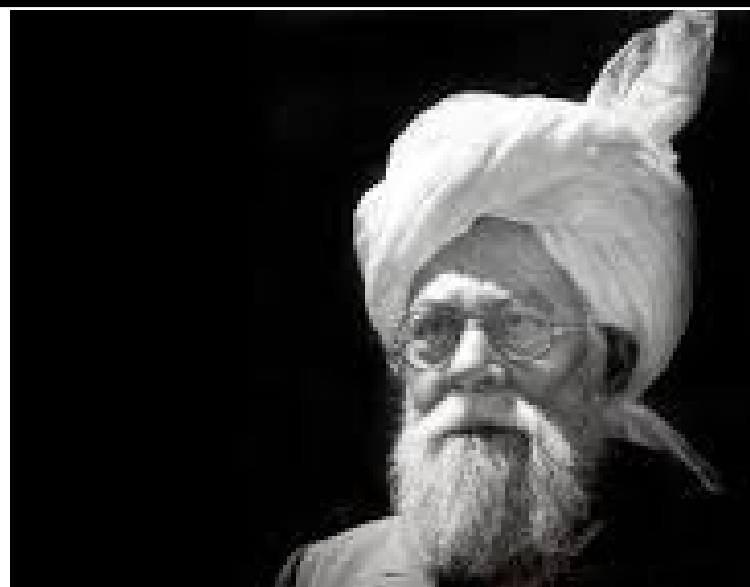

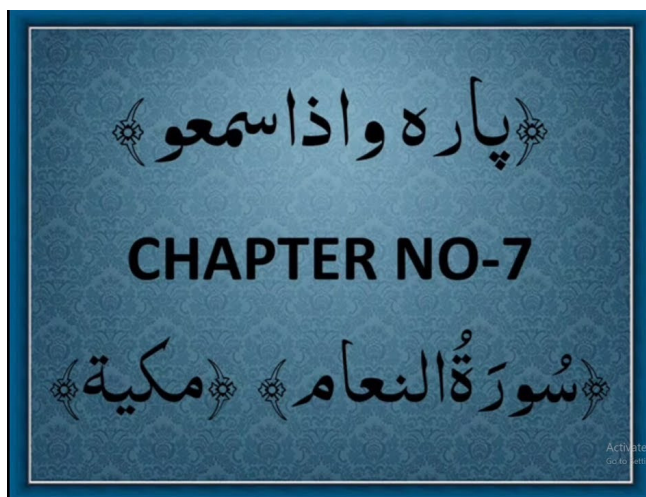
For the above verse Hazrat Musleh Maud(ra) was elaborating in Tafseer-e- Kabeer as follows:-

936. Commentary: The point is worthy of special note that, like some previous verses (e.g. 7:27, 28 & 32), the address in the words, O children of Adam, is here made to the people of the Holy Prophet's time and to the generations that are yet to be born and not to the people who lived in the distant past and followed Adam immediately. This form of address has been employed with a view to introducing an important subject which was to be conveyed to future generations of mankind. This is to the effect that Messengers of God will continue to appear as long as the children of Adam live upon this earth and that the opposition of the Holy Prophet's enemies would not bring about his down fall nor the cessation of prophethood. The great promise



O children of Adam, is here made to the people of the Holy Prophet's time and to the generations that are yet to be born and not to the people who lived in the distant past and followed Adam immediately

which was held out to the progeny of Adam in the time of Adam (2:39) and according to which Messengers of God appeared among peoples in different countries at different times will continue to be different fulfilled till the end of time. The words, if Messengers come to you from among yourselves, do not mean that Messengers of God may or may not come, just as the words, If there comes to you guidance from Me (2:39)***, do not mean that guidance might or might not come. Indeed, the word 'اما' (if) is intended to mean that if you happen to live at a

time when a Messenger of God appears, you should not fail to accept him. Thus the word is simply meant to leave the time unfixed; the Messenger of God may appear in one generation or another but whenever he appears, he must be accepted. The words, rehearsing My Signs unto you, hint at the fact that the Messengers who were to come after the Holy Prophet were to bring no new Law but were to follow the Law of Islam; they were simply to "rehearse" or recite the verses already revealed in the Quran.

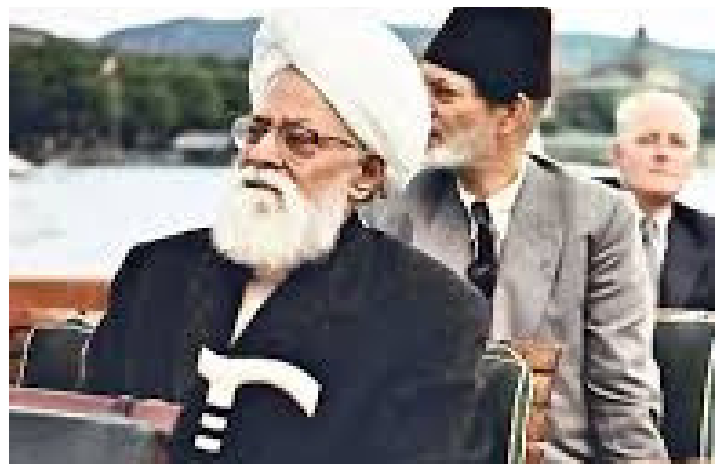
937. Commentary: This verse serves as a particular warning for Muslims that they should not make light of the Messengers who would appear among them and should not reject them. The Law has indeed been made perfect in the Quran; but that does not mean that later Messengers of God may be rejected with impunity so with respect to above verses of Holy Quran as Muslims we never reject such claims blindly and the same time, if we happen to meet divinely Elects of Allah

***We said: 'Go forth, all of you, from here. And if there comes to you guidance from Me, then whoso shall follow My guidance, on them shall come no fear, nor shall they grieve.' (Quran 2:39)

we have to accept based on teachings of his scriptures and divinely signs InshaAllah, Ameen and Hazrat Musleh Maud (ra) further explaining

938. Commentary: The verse gives the reasons why the rejecters of Divine Messengers deserve severe punishment. People incur the wrath of God because they treat His Messenger as a liar and reject the heavenly signs he brings with him. Indeed, impostors and the rejecters of true Messengers are equally doomed and can never escape the punishment ordained for them. The words, who shall have their lot as ordained, mean that the rejecters of God's Messengers will see before their very eyes the fulfillment of the prophecies foretelling their defeat and discomfiture and shall taste of the punishment promised to them for opposing God's Messengers.

4897: "While we were sitting with the Prophet (ﷺ) & Surat Al-Jumu 'ah was revealed to him, and when the Verse, "And [He (Allah) has sent him (Prophet Muhammad (ﷺ)) also to] others among them (Muslims) who have not yet joined them.....(V.62 :4) was recited by the Prophet , I said, "Who are they, O Allah's Messenger (ﷺ)?" The Prophet did not reply till I repeated my question thrice. At that time, Salman Al-Fārisi was with us. So Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) put his hand on Salman, saying, "If Faith were at (the place of) Ath-Thuraiyya (pleiades, on of the highest star), even then (some men or man) from these people (i.e., Salman's folk) would have taken it"

4898: The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "Then **some** from these people (i.e. Salman's folk) would have taken it ."(in the above hadith)

Alhamdulillah Summa Alhamdulillah, based on the above Hadith we have accepted Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad (as) from Qadiyan as the second coming of Jesus (as) and also as the Promised Messiah of the past century and now here the question is whether there can be more than one Massih who comes in the Ummah of Holy Prophet Muhammad (ﷺ). If we accept that the Promised Massih is only one, then certainly it is against the teaching of the Holy Quran. Since Allah (swt) says in Holy Quran:

If we accept Massih is one then certainly it is against teaching of Holy Quran , Since Allah swt says in Holy Quran

"And Joseph did come to you before with clear proofs, but you ceased not to be in doubt concerning that with which he came to you till, when he died, you said: 'Allah will never raise up a Messenger after him.' Thus does Allah adjudge as lost those who transgress, and are doubters." (40:35)

It is a fact that if we accept the coming of the Messiah as one advent only, then that it is another form or the replica of finality of prophethood, because Hazrat Muhammad (ﷺ) prophesied "Massih is Nabiullah". Certainly, in the Ummah of Muhammad (ﷺ) only "massih is Nabiullah". So think if we say Massih is one, then in the above verse Allah has categorically denied the cessation of prophethood and calls those who claim that now no new prophet shall ever come, as gone astray, transgressors and doubters. God has made the Ummah of Hazrat Muhammad (ﷺ) the best of all (Khairi Ummah) and further, the community established by Hadrat Musa (as) - Moses - continued after him through the Prophets of his image; Similarly, since the dawn of time, whenever there arises any deficiency in the mindset of the people His Deen,

"if we accept Messiah is one then that it is another form or the replica of finality of prophet-hood."

Allah the Almighty sends some persons who reform these people, and those elects may also be called Prophets. Then, how can we call the Ummah-Muhammadiyah the best if the people within it closes the door of prophethood? On the contrary, this door is always open, never shut and Allah keeps on talking to his elects. This is the beauty of the teachings of Allah and Prophet Muhammad (ﷺ). Hazrat Masih-e-Maud (as) also categorically denied that he alone is the Massih of Ummah-Muhammadiyah and he teaches us :-

"It is also evident that this view is not mine alone. The 'mirror images' of the Massih could be several persons"- **This is also not just a personal opinion of mine. This is actually the essence of the great prophetic traditions in this regard. There could be around 30 Dajjals till the Day of Judgement. Thus 30 Dajjals might appear in the world. Based on the prophecy "Li Kulli Dajjalin Isa", at least 30 Massihis should come.** Due to these descriptions, the other Massihis will make an appearance at some other time. All this is perfectly possible" and further he writes,

"I am the one who claims to be the Promised Massih. But I do not claim to be the only one or the first and last Promised Massih. In my view, after my age, 10,000 Promised Massihis shall come. But for this age, I am the only Promised Massih" (Izala Auham pg.197)

Now, after reading the above statement by the Promised Messiah Mirza Ghulam Ahmad Qadiani (as), our belief as Muslims should be crystal clear that the advent of the Messiah is not just one advent, but one or more advents. What has happened to the beliefs of the Ahmadies now? The writings of Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad (as) is very clear. Will they deny those writings or distort them ? Will they have the courage to say that these writings and/ or sayings are true? Will they ever believe?

NABI E KAREEM HAZRAT MUHAMMAD MUSTAFA [SAW]



And Muhammad (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) was imaam of all the prophets, on the night of the Mi'raaj, because no one but the best is put forward. More evidence that he is the best of them comes from Abu Hurayrah, who said: "The Messenger of Allaah (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: 'I will be the leader of the sons of Adam on the Day of Resurrection, and the first one for whom the grave will be opened, and the first to intercede, and the first whose intercession will be accepted.'" (Narrated by Muslim, al-Fadaa'il, 4223)

Ibn Kaseer said that the Sacred House which is in Jerusalem, the origin of the Prophets from the time of Ibrahim Al-Khalil. The Prophets all gathered there, and he (Muhammad (Sal)) led them in prayer in their own homeland. This indicates that he is the greatest leader of all, may the peace and blessings of Allah be upon him and upon them. (Tafsir ibn Kathir: Sura 17. Al-Isra' Verse: 1)

The journey of Mi'raaj shows that Prophet Muhammad (sa) is superior to all the Prophets. Prophet (pbuh) has crossed each and every heaven from Makkah and went beyond the seven heavens and reached up to Sathratul Munthaha and had conversation with the Lord. All those prophets who appeared in this earth are in the seven heavens, according to their status. Whereas, Prophet (pbuh) had crossed the seven heavens which are the spiritual status of all the prophets and reached Sathratul Munthaha. If one looks at the sky from the earth, it can be seen that all the prophets are in the seven heavens whereas Prophet (sa) is in the final boundary beyond all of them. This status is the last status of Nubuwwat. According to Arabic language when the word Khatam comes after the plural word prophets—the word khatam among the prophets means the best among the prophets. Allah says Prophet (sa) as Kattamun Nabiyeen—the best of the Prophets. This status is not given to any other Prophet.

The Prophet ﷺ said, "I have been given five things which were not given to any one else before me.

1. Allah made me victorious by awe, (by His frightening my enemies) for a distance of one month's journey.
2. The earth has been made for me (and for my followers) a place for praying and a thing to perform Tayammum, therefore anyone of my followers can pray wherever the time of a prayer is due.
3. The booty has been made Halal (lawful) for me yet it was not lawful for anyone else before me.
4. I have been given the right of intercession (on the Day of Resurrection).
5. Every Prophet used to be sent to his nation only but I have been sent to all mankind) [Bukhari, Muslim & Nasa'i]

Holy Qur'an (17:80) says: "It may be that thy Lord will raise thee to an exalted station (maqam-e-mehmood)". This most exalted station was never granted to any of the prophets.

And Holy Qur'an (108:2) says: "Surely We have given thee abundance of good (Kauthar)". This privilege has not been given to any other prophets. Only the Holy prophet (sal) has the first right to recommend Paradise in the Hereafter.

It was narrated that Anas bin Malik said: "The Messenger of Allah (sa) said: 'I will be the first of the people to intercede concerning Paradise, and I will be the Prophet with the greatest number of followers'" (Sahih Muslim ch: 85, No. 330).

Allah has only given Hazrat Prophet(sa) the right to call "Oh My servants!"(Qul Ya Ibadi)[Quran39:54]. Among those Prophets who received the Scriptures, only Prophet (sa) has received the complete and Ultimate Scripture which will last till the Last Day and for the entire mankind. Holy Prophet (sa) said: ".....I will be the chief of all the people on the Day of Resurrection.". (Bukhari No.3340)

People will go to prophets Adam(as), Noah(as), Ibrahim(as), Moses(as), Isa(as) etc., and plead to intercede for them, but they will not intercession. Finally, it is when they come to the Holy Prophet(sa) for intercession that the Lord will accept it from him.

Narrated Anas bin Malik: Reported that the Messenger of Allah صلى الله عليه وسلم said: "I am the first of the people to appear upon their being resurrected, and I am their spokesman whenever they gather, and I am the one that gives them glad tidings whenever they give up hope. And the Banner of Praise will be in my hand that day, and I am the most noble of the children of Adam with my Lord, and I am not boasting." (Jami`at-Tirmidhi, Vol. 6, Book of Al-Manaqib (Virtues), Hadith 3610)

"... Hazrat Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم said: "Upon the Day of Judgement I will be the leader of the Prophets and their spokesman, and the bearer of their intercession, without bragging." (Jami` at-Tirmidhi, Vol. 6, Book of Al-Manaqib (Virtues), Hadith 3613). The Messenger of Allah (pbuh) said: "I will come to the gate of paradise on the Day of Resurrection and would seek its opening and the keeper would say: Who art thou? I would say: Muhammad. He would then say: It is for thee that I have been ordered, and not to open it for anyone before thee. (Narrator: Anas bin Malik(ral), Kitab Al Iman, No#384, Sahih Muslim).



PLEASURE IN PRAYER

What is the formal Prayer? It is a special form of supplication to the Divine, but people consider it to be a tax that is due to kings. These foolish people do not even know that God Almighty has no need for such things. What need does His Independent Being have for man to pray to Him, extol His glory and praise Him, besought of all as He is? In fact, it is man who derives benefit and reaches his objective through these means. It gives me great pain to observe that in this day and age there is no love for worship, virtue and piety. The reason for this is the poisonous, widespread effect of evil custom. It is for this reason that the love of Allah Almighty is falling cold and people do not experience the pleasure they ought to in worship. There is nothing (in the world) which according to the design of Allah Almighty does not give pleasure or satisfaction in some form. A person who is ill cannot derive pleasure from even the most exquisite and delicious food, and considers it to be bitter or completely tasteless. So too is the case with those people who derive no pleasure and delight from the worship of God. Such people should worry about their ill state. For as I have just said, there is nothing on earth, which Allah the Exalted has not instilled with the characteristic of granting pleasure in some form or other. Allah the Exalted has created man so that he may worship Him. Why then would there be no pleasure and delight in this worship? There is definitely pleasure and delight in worship. If only there were those who would take it. Allah the Exalted states:

"And I have not created the Jinn and the men but that they may worship Me."

Does man not derive pleasure from looking at beautiful things, whether plants or minerals, animals or other human beings? Do the ears not derive pleasure from attractive and beautiful voices? Now when the very purpose of man's creation is worship, it is necessary for there to be immense pleasure and satisfaction in worship. We can appreciate this very well from our daily observation and experience. For example, grain along with all the things that we eat and drink have been created for humans. Do they not then derive a pleasure and satisfaction from these things? Does man not possess a tongue so that he can experience the taste, flavour and sensation that is associated with these things? Does man not derive pleasure from looking at beautiful things, whether plants or minerals, animals or other human beings? Do the ears not derive pleasure from attractive and beautiful voices? Then is any further argument required to establish the fact that there is pleasure to be derived in worship? Allah the Exalted states: We have created man and woman as mates and we have inclined man towards his mate. God has not made it so by way of coercion, but rather, He has encouraged by way of pleasure. If procreation and reproduction was the only intended purpose, this would not fulfil the actual objective. In a state of nakedness, shame would prevent a man and woman from having

intimate relations with one another. However, God has made this process a source of pleasure and satisfaction for both man and woman. This pleasure and satisfaction is so great that there are some ignorant people who do not even care for children, and the only thing that they are interested in is pleasure. The actual purpose of God Almighty was the continuation of human beings, and for this objective he fostered a relationship between man and woman, and as a secondary element invested this relation with pleasure, which for many unwise people has become the only intended purpose. In the same manner, bear well in mind that worship is no burden or tax. This too possesses a pleasure and satisfaction; and this pleasure and satisfaction is far greater than all the delights of this world and all carnal pleasures. Although there is pleasure in the mutual relation between man and woman, only such men can derive satisfaction from this who are in the full possession of their faculties. An impotent man or a eunuch cannot find pleasure in such relations. Moreover, just as an ill person remains deprived of the pleasure of even the finest and most exquisite foods, so too is precisely the case with the unfortunate person who does not find pleasure in worshipping Allah. The bond between man and woman is a superficial and temporary one. I say that the everlasting epitome of pleasure in its truest sense exists in the bond between man and God Almighty. I feel an immense agony, which at times consumes my soul, that if even one day a person is unable to enjoy the taste of their food, they will visit the doctor and beg and beseech them, even flatter them, and spend money and bear pains so that the pleasure they once felt may return. The impotent man who is unable to feel pleasure with his wife will at times feel so disturbed that he begins to contemplate suicide, and there are many cases of such deaths. But alas! Why does the ineffectual person with an ailing heart not make an effort to experience pleasure in worship? Why does such a one not feel miserable with grief? They will go to great lengths in pursuit of the world and its pleasures, but feel no thirst or agony for true and everlasting pleasure. How unfortunate is such a person? How deprived are they? They will search for a cure in order to experience temporary and transient

pleasures and they are successful. Is it possible then that there be no cures which enable one to experience that pleasure which is enduring and everlasting? There are indeed. But perseverance and persistence are needed in the search for truth. In the Holy Quran, Allah the Exalted has described the believers in similitude to women. There is a deep and hidden secret in this point. Those who believe have been likened to Mary and Asiyah; that is to say, God Almighty brings forth believers from among the idolaters. In any case, by likening believers to women there is in actuality a subtle mystery that has been revealed. To elaborate, just as a mutual relation exists between man and woman, so too is the relationship of man's servitude and divine providence. If a man and woman have a mutual understanding with one another and both are attracted to one another, then such couples are blessed and fruitful; otherwise domestic life is ruined and the actual purpose of this relationship goes unrealised. Men ruin themselves through other relations and are struck by hundreds of illnesses. Some contract infectious diseases like syphilis and are left deprived in this very world. And if such people do happen to have children, many future generations are left

Affected by this illness. On the other hand, the woman will begin to lead a life of immodesty and even after her honour and dignity has drowned completely, she is unable to attain true comfort. they succeed in garnering for themselves a reputation for being holy and pious. Why are such people not consumed by grief that if such false, superficial and insincere Prayers can grant them such a status, why would they not be conferred with dignity if they become true servants of God? In fact, much greater honour would be bestowed upon them in such a case. In short, I observe that people are negligent and indolent in observing their Prayers because they are oblivious to the pleasure and satisfaction that Allah the Exalted has invested in Prayer. This is a significant cause in this respect. Then, there is even greater negligence and indolence in cities and towns. Even fifty percent of the people do not eagerly bow their heads before their true Master with sincere love. The question that arises is: why do the people not know of this pleasure and why have they never experienced this exquisite taste? Other religions do not prescribe such injunctions.

It is for these reasons that a Khalifatullah becomes for the Ummah of Hazrat Muhammad (peace be upon him) a wealth of blessings.

This divine manifestation has been amply demonstrated by God, with the arrival of a Khalifatullah where there is a spiritual revolution, especially when Islam (the universal religion) is now in a painful and difficult situation

Problems did not wait to come to the surface. When we see many so-called Muslims, and great defenders of Islam trampling the teachings of Islam, we realize that they are Muslims in name only.

Now let us see what the Promised Messiah, the founder of Jamaat Ahmadiyya (on him be peace) has said. In his book Shahadat'ul Quran (on pg. 48 - 60), the Promised Messiah (on him be peace) said:

“‘Qudrat-e-Saniyah’ is everlasting and will end till the day of Judgement”. The meaning of the Promised Messiah (on him be peace), in this sentence concerning the word “**Qudrat-e-Saniyah**” implies to “**Khilafat**”. **And according to the Promised Messiah (on him be peace), “Khilafat” does not only implies to “Khilafat-e-Rassool” but it also implies to “Mujaddid”.** The Promised Messiah (on him be peace) believes that “**Khilafat**” includes “**the four rightly guided successors of Rassool**” and Allah willed that it should continue to exist permanently till the Day of Judgement.

Thus, the Promised Messiah (on him be peace) **has not declared the “Ahmadiyya Khilafat”** everlasting in his writings. What he has declared everlasting are two things:

1) Qudrat-e-Saniyah

2) Islamic Khilafat.

1) Qudrat-e-Saniyah:-

“Qudrat is similar to the Qudrat which appeared in the form of Hazrat Abu Bakr, the first Islamic Khalifa which means “Qudrat-e-Saniyah” is comparable to the “Islamic Khilafat””

Qudrat-e-Saniyah includes “Khilafat” and not just the “Ahmadiyya Khilafat”, because the Promised Messiah (on him be peace) wrote in the same book Al-Wassiyat (The Will) that this Qudrat is similar to the Qudrat which appeared in the form of Hazrat Abu Bakr, the first Islamic Khalifa which means “Qudrat-e-Saniyah” is comparable to the “Islamic Khilafat”

2. Islamic Khilafat :-

includes successors of the Prophets, Mujaddidin, Messiahs or Khalifatullahs In the time of the Promised Messiah (on him be peace),

A man asked him a question:- “**Will a Mujaddid come after you?**”

The Promised Messiah replied :- “What is wrong with a Mujaddid coming after me?”

He said that, the prophethood of Moses had come to an end, and that is why his chain of successors ended with Jesus. However, the dispensation of the Holy Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him) will last till the Day of Judgement. Therefore, Mujaddidin will arise in it till Judgement Day. As long as the Day of Judgement withholds its destruction, it does not matter that someone else should come. We most certainly do not deny that good and righteous people will continue to come and then all of a sudden the Day of Judgement will come.” (Malfoozat Vol.7 Pg. 119)

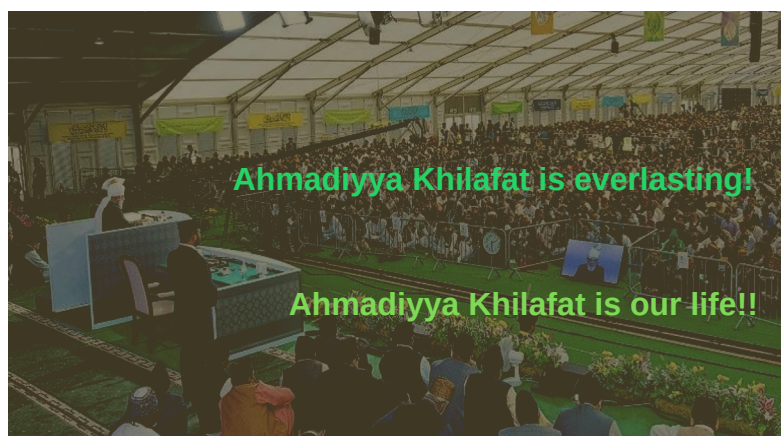

What are the Basic Duties in Islam ?

This article is in response to a question asked by an Islamic friend in the social networking group called "Question and Answer"

Assalamualaikum Warahmathullahi Wabarakathahu to all my brothers in this group, A few days ago, a brother had asked a question about what are the basic duties of Islam and some of the brothers had replied as well. If you ask what are the duties of Islam then our answer will be very easily, five obligations. Even this answer can be known to non Islamic school students too, since the available textbooks also described same. But there is much more to it than that. InshaAllah we will find the answer to this beautiful question under the light of Ahadith, teachings of the Promised Messiah (as) and Musleh Maud - The Promised Son (ra).

Let's begin with the teachings from the sacred mouth of the Holy Prophet (pbuh). Narrated Ibn Abbas: Allah's Apostle صلى الله عليه وسلم said to Muadh bin Jabal when he sent him to Yemen. "You will come to the people of Scripture, and when you reach them, invite them to testify that none has the right to be worshipped except Allah and that Muhammad is His Apostle. And if they obey you in that, then tell them that Allah has enjoined on them five prayers to be performed every day and night. And if they obey you in that, then tell them that Allah has enjoined on them Sadaqa (i.e. Zakat) to be taken from the rich amongst them and given to the poor amongst them. And if they obey you in that, then be cautious! Don't take their best properties (as Zakat) and be afraid of the curse of an oppressed person as there is no screen between his invocation and Allah.

Here our beloved master (sa) clearly states that all other duties of Islam is obligatory only after the first part of the Kalima, that is, "Laa 'Ilaaha 'Il-lal-laah," which means that "No one is worthy of worship except Allah." Hence, the first and foremost principle by which any Muslim must live his

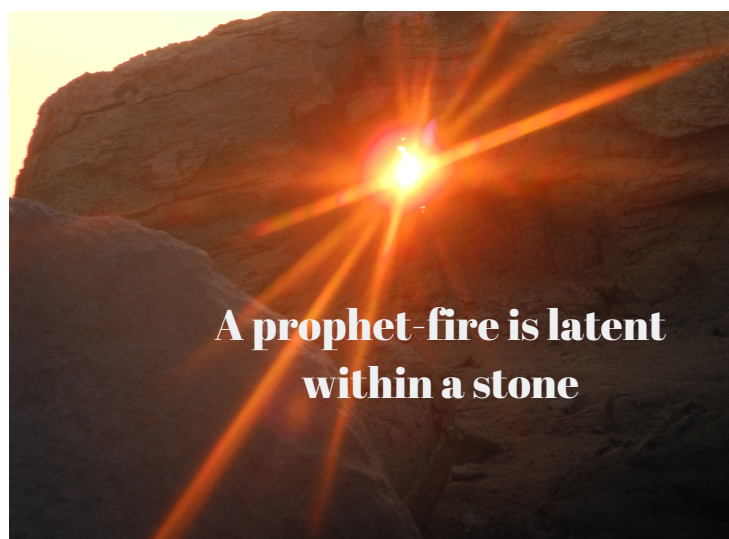
or her life is that of Tauheed and this part of the Kalima requires a firm belief in prophets of Allah. This perfect statement was confirmed by the words of the Promised Messiah(as) which is essentially based on the following Quranic verse:-

Surely, those who disbelieve in Allah and His Messengers and desire to make a distinction between Allah and His Messengers, and say, 'We believe in some and disbelieve in others,' and desire to take a way in between, these indeed are veritable disbelievers, and We have prepared for the disbelievers a humiliating punishment. And as for those who believe in Allah and in all of His Messengers and make no distinction between any of them, these are they whom He will soon give their rewards. And Allah is Most Forgiving, Merciful. (4:151-153)

Those people who reject Allah and the Messenger and seek to create a divide between God and His Messengers, saying, 'We believe in some and not in others'—in other words, belief in God alone or belief in some Messengers is enough and it is unnecessary to believe in the Messenger (sa) or all the Prophets in conjunction with the belief in God—and they seek to discard divine guidance, adopting an incomplete religion instead; such indeed are confirmed disbelievers, and We have prepared a humiliating punishment for the disbelievers. And those who believe in God and the Messenger, and do not create discord between God and His Messengers—that is, do not adopt this divisive belief in God alone and not His Messengers, nor do they like the schism of believing in some of the Prophets while rejecting others—God shall give such people their reward.

It is obvious that the Prophets died at their appointed times. This injunction that 'when that particular Messenger appears they must believe in him, otherwise they will be held accountable,' applies to the followers of all Prophets

Huzur(as) further went on to say, The secret underlying this is that man has been invested with the capacity of believing in Tawheed in the way that fire is latent within a stone. The person of a Messenger is like a flint who strikes the stone by focusing his attention upon it and brings out that latent fire in the stone. It is not possible, therefore, that without the flint of a Prophet, the spark of Tawheed may be ignited in any heart. It is only a Prophet who brings down Tawheed upon the earth

Were salvation possible through belief in barren Tawheed alone, why would God hold such people accountable who are convinced of Tawheed, but do not believe in the Holy Prophet, may peace and blessings of Allah be upon him? further He(as) throw light on this subject while explaining the Holy Quran verse 3:82 is that And remember the time when God took a covenant from all the Messengers: 'When I shall give you the Book and Wisdom and then, in the Latter Days, shall come My Messenger who will testify to the truth of your Books, you will have to believe in him and will have to help him.' Then He asked, 'Have you agreed and become firm on this covenant?' They said, 'We have agreed.' At this, Allah said, 'Now be witness to this covenant of yours and along with you, I too am a witness over it.

Now it is obvious that the Prophets died at their appointed times. This injunction that 'when that particular Messenger appears they must believe in him, otherwise they will be held accountable,' applies to the followers of all Prophets.

**The path of those on whom Thou hast bestowed
Thy blessings (1:7)**

While God enjoins you to supplicate five times a day for the blessings which belong to the Prophets and Messengers of God, how is it possible for you to acquire these blessings without their help? It is, therefore, essential in order to help you attain the stage of certainty and love that Prophets of God should continue to appear from time to time so that you may receive these blessings from them. Do you wish to challenge God Almighty and violate His eternal law? Can a sperm say that it did not want to be born of a father? Can the ears declare that they do not want to hear through the medium of air? Nothing can be more foolish than to challenge the age-old law of God Almighty.

However, every sensible person would realise that such a doctrine reduces the advent of Prophets, peace be upon them, to be an exercise in futility and fruitlessness. If one could still attain salvation through belief in God being One even while refuting and opposing the Prophets, peace be upon them, would this not perforce mean that the Prophets were sent to the world in vain even without them the task could be managed—and there was no great need for their advent? Were it true that a mere affirmation of the Oneness of God was enough, then by implication it would amount to a kind of shirk [association of partners with God] to require the addition of the words مُحَمَّدٌ رَّسُولُ اللَّهِ [Muhammad is the Messenger of Allah] to لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ [There is no God but Allah]. The fact of the matter is that for those who think along these lines, it is a veritable shirk to pronounce مُحَمَّدٌ رَّسُولُ اللَّهِ (Muhammad is the Messenger of Allah). According to them, perfect Tauhid [Oneness of God] means that no other name should be joined with Him. Also, in their estimation, to be outside of the religion of Islam does not preclude salvation. For example, should all Muslims, in a single day, reject the Prophethood of the Holy Prophet, may peace and blessings of Allah be upon him, and, like misguided philosophers, consider Tauhid alone to be sufficient [for salvation] and imagine that they need not follow the Holy Quran and the Holy Prophet, may peace and blessings of Allah be upon him, and reject them, even then—according to these people—all of them, despite being apostates, will attain salvation and, without a doubt, enter Paradise

It is sheer arrogance to believe that one does not stand in need of God's Messengers and Prophets; such a belief signifies the loss of faith; and such a person only deceives himself when he says, 'Do I not offer the Salat, observe the Fast and recite the Kalima?'. He is hidden beyond hidden and concealed beyond concealed—reveals Himself. That Hidden Treasure, whose name is God, has always been known through the Prophets. To realize without the agency of a Prophet that Tawheed—which is estimated as true Tawheed, Through this, it is crystal clear that the Prophets and Messengers are the master of spiritual treasures!!!

And further I want to remember the Tafseer Hazrat Masih e Maud for the verse 7:35, The point is worthy of special note that, like some previous verses (e.g. 7:27, 28 & 32), the address in the words, O children of Adam, is here made to the people of the Holy Prophet's time and to the generations that are yet to be born and not to the people who lived in the distant past and followed Adam immediately. This form of address has been employed with a view to introducing an important subject which was to be conveyed to future generations of mankind. This is to the effect that Messengers of God will continue to appear as long as the children of Adam live upon this earth and that the opposition of the Holy Prophet's enemies would not bring about his down fall nor the cessation of

Prophethood. The great promise which was held out to the progeny of Adam in the time of Adam (2:39) and according to which Messengers of God appeared among peoples in different countries at different times will

continue to be different fulfilled till the end of time. The words, if Messengers come to you from among yourselves, do not mean that Messengers of God may or may not come, just as the words, If there comes to you guidance from Me (2:39), do not mean that guidance might or might not come. Indeed, the word 'La' (if) is intended to mean that if you happen to live at a time when a Messenger of God appears, you should not fail to accept him. Thus the word is simply meant to leave the time unfixed; the Messenger of God may appear in one generation or another but whenever he appears, he must be accepted. The words, rehearsing My Signs unto you, hint at the fact that the Messengers who were to come after the Holy Prophet were to bring no new Law but were to follow the Law of Islam; they were simply to "rehearse" or recite the verses already revealed in the Quran.



The person of a Messenger is like a flint who strikes the stone by focusing his attention upon it and brings out that latent fire in the stone. It is not possible, therefore, that without the flint of a Prophet

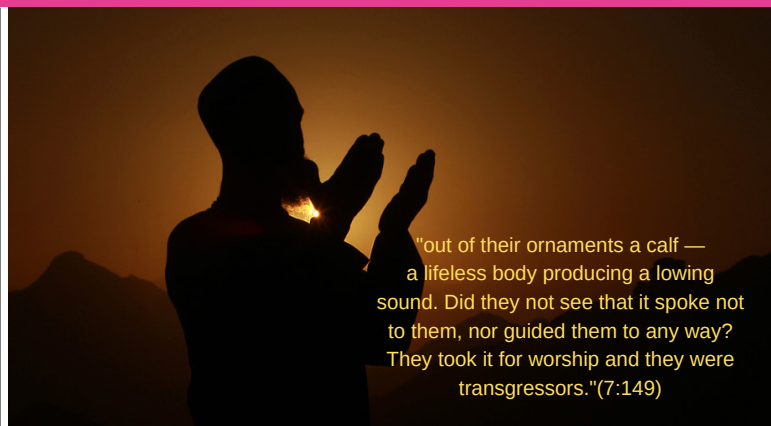
There is a wrong notion among Muslims that God has stopped speaking to human through his revelation. If God spoke to His servants in the past, why does He not talk to them now? If He used to send His guidance in times of trouble, doubt and bewilderment, why does He not open for men the door to His guidance today? There is no testimony to prove that god has stopped speaking to Human. The truth is that He bestows His speech he speaks today as he spoke earlier. Believing he does not speak with men after Prophet (sa) is most unfortunate . to prove this statement Allah swt says in Holy Quran :

“As for those who say; ‘Our Lord is Allah’; and then remain steadfast, the angels descend on them saying: ‘Fear ye not, nor grieve: and rejoice in the garden that you were promised “ (41:31)

This verse attests that angels descend on those believers who remain steadfast .According to the above verse if none of the believers receive revelation after Prophet (sa), then it is equal to consider them as believers who do not remain firm and steadfast. Will God not speak with those who faithfully follows Him? What is the difference between believers and non-believers if God doesn't communicate with the believers ? Another verse from The Holy Quran states that:

“He sends down the angels with revelation by His command on whomsoever of His servant He pleases.” (16:3). “He is of most exalted attributes, Lord of the Throne. He sends the Word by his command to whomsoever of His servants He pleases, that He may give the warning of the Day of Meeting,”(40:16)

It is made sure from the above two verses that God sends His revelation through angels to His servants. The three verses mentioned above has the words “Thathanassilu”, “Yunassilu”, and “Yuhya” These words indicate the present and the future . Therefore the verse does not consider the past.” Hazrat Prophet (s.a) had said that “revelation always endures in the community” in Hadith based on revelation.

Sahih al Bukhari: God has spoken to Israeli's who were not his messenger. There are such people who receive revelation in my community as well. Hazrat Umar (ra) is one among them .(Buhari-chapter Manahibumar).When there was a question raised as Who is "Muhaddas" the holy Prophet (sa) answered that "Muhaddas" is a person to whom God speaks in his own language. (ThariqulKulaba-Dipri).From these two Hadith it is clear that God has spoken to others in Prophet (saw) period and after his period as well. The revelation descends on the Promised Messiah through Gibreal.

“Allah will send a Reviver of Religion (al mujaddid) within this community (al ummah), and this at the beginning of each century.” (Abu Dawud)

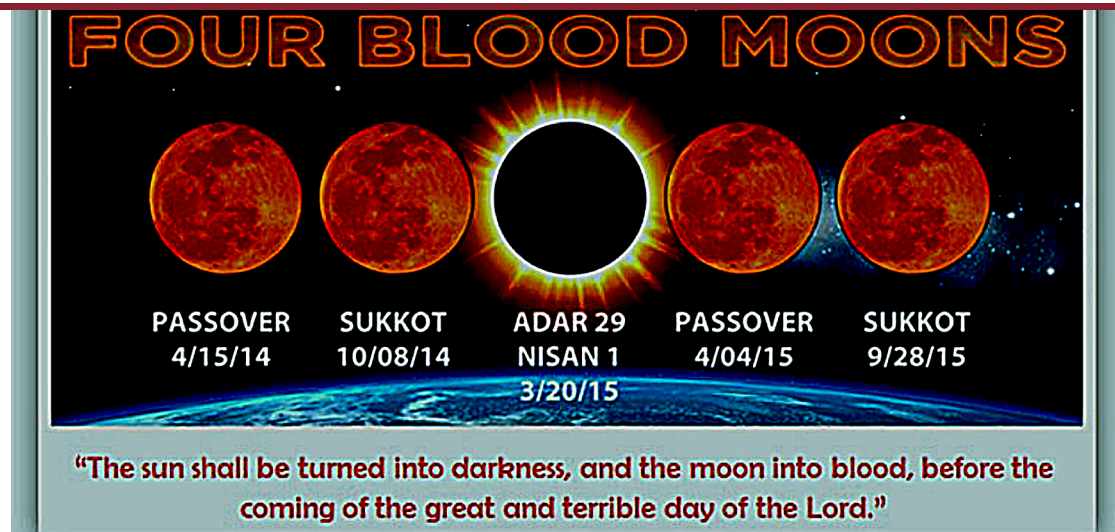

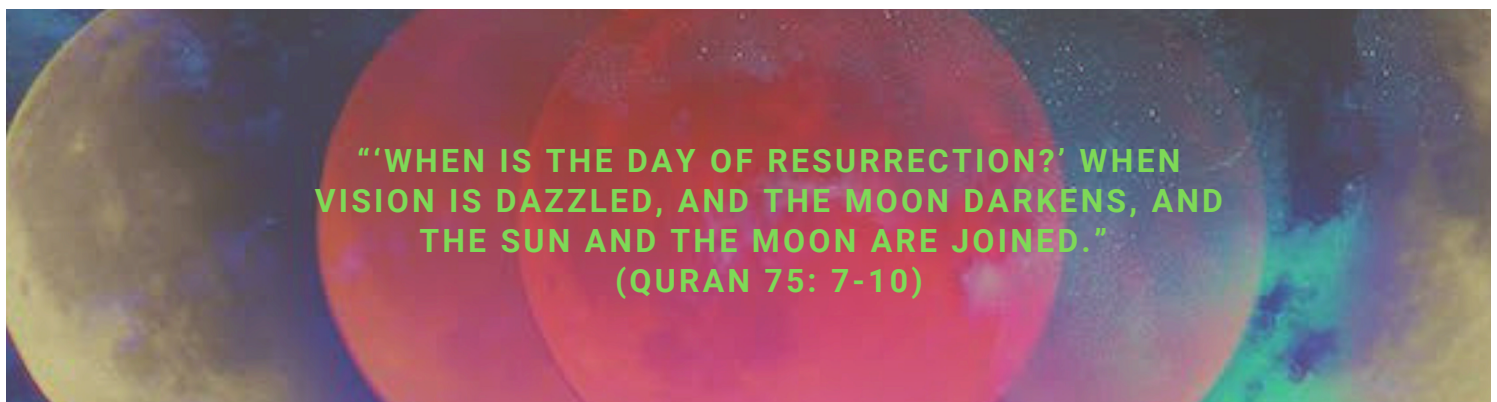

This time though, during the night of Sunday 27 to Monday 28 September 2015, the full moon passed through the shadow of the earth. 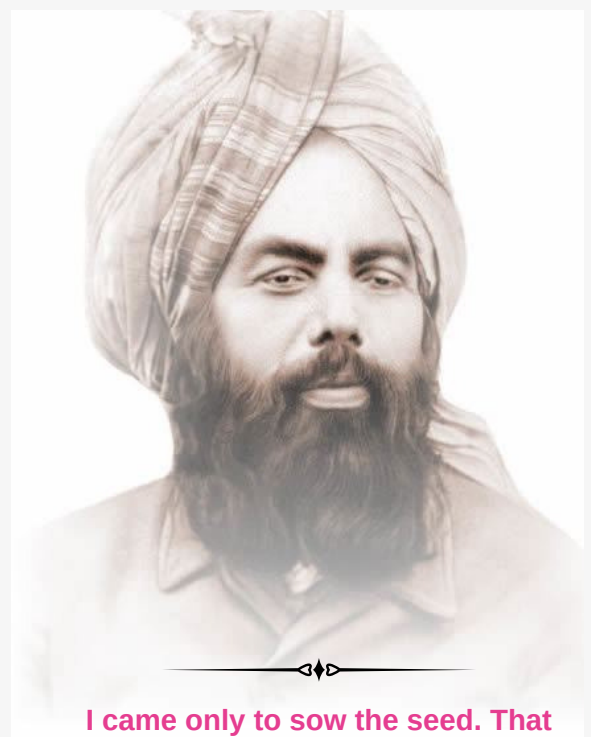

(An-Najmus Saqib, Vol. 2, p. 209),have seen the light of the day; and at the exact time—in the beginning of the 14th century, the First Messiah in Islam, Hazrat Mirza Ghulam Ahmad(as), having received knowledge from God the Exalted, made the following announcements from Qadian,as was predicted by the Holy Prophet,exactly from Hijri 1290.

"This is something unique and a great sign of God that He began pouring down His revelations on me exactly in 1290 Hijri". (Haqiqatul Wahi). The advent of such a Buruz was ordained by God Almighty, as He says:-

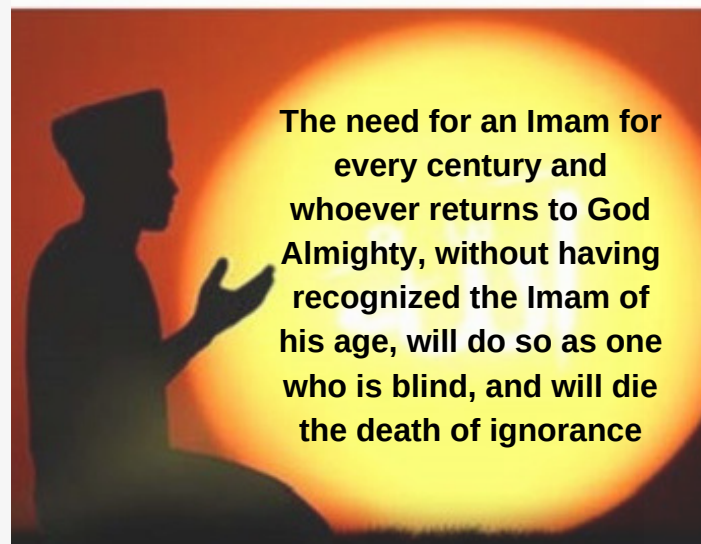

"He will raise him among others of them who have not yet joined them..." (Surah Al-Jumuah 62:4)

And further Holy prophet (sa) warns us "What will be your condition when the son of Mary will descend among you and he will be your **Imam** from among yourselves." (Bukhari, Kitabul Anbiya, Bab Nazool Isa), so unambiguous coming of messiah that is coming of Buruzes(reflections) of Holy prophet(sa) are the Imam of the age.
